RE: COLORADO SPRINGS MAYORAL RUN-OFF SURVEY TOPLINE RESULTS

Magellan Data and Mapping Strategies are pleased to present the topline results of a 755N autodial survey of likely general election voters in Colorado Springs. The interviews were conducted May 9th -10th, 2011. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.56% at the 95 percent confidence interval. This survey was weighted based upon voter turnout demographics from the 2010 and 2006 general election cycles.

Thinking now about another topic.....

In 2010, El Paso County Commissioners placed a “term limits” question on the ballot. The ballot question asked voters to “limit the terms of county officials to three terms.” The question wording did not state that voting yes would actually increase the number of terms county officials could serve from the current two terms to three terms.

T6. Knowing this, do you think the El Paso County Commissioners should place another, more clearly defined term limits question on the ballot to give voters a choice between limiting county officials to either two terms or three terms?
