**RE: COLORADO 2018 GOVERNOR REPUBLICAN PRIMARY SURVEY SUMMARY**

This memorandum is a summary of an automated voice recorded survey of 647 likely Republican primary voters in Colorado. The interviews were conducted on February 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.85% at the 95 percent confidence interval. The results were weighted to reflect the voter turnout demographics of past Republican primary elections in Colorado.

**Key Findings**

- Treasurer Walker Stapleton currently leads the Republican field for Governor by 13 points with 26% support, followed by Attorney General Cynthia Coffman with 13%, Doug Robinson with 8%, and businessman Victor Mitchell with 5%. Nine percent of primary voters support the “other” candidate and 39% of voters are undecided.
- By an overwhelming margin, 43%, the top issue that primary voters want the Republican candidates for Governor to be addressing the most is enforcing our immigration laws.
- President Trump continues to maintain sky-high approval ratings among the Republican base with 82% of respondents approving of the job he is doing and only 13% disapproving.

**Observations of the Governor Republican Primary Ballot Test**

With former Congressman Tom Tancredo’s exit from the race, the Republican field for Governor appears to finally be settled. It is a little less congested, and the all-important “immigration first” voters, 43% of all respondents, will be looking for a new candidate to support. Among “immigration” voters, 26% support Walker Stapleton, 11% support Cynthia Coffman, 9% support Doug Robinson, and 8% support some other candidate.

However, nearly half of all immigration voters, and 39% of all respondents, are currently undecided in their choice for Governor. Although the field is settled, there is a long way to go before this primary is decided. The truth is, a lot of money will be spent by the campaigns between now and the June 26<sup>th</sup> primary. Between now and then, voters will be watching and listening to the candidates as they introduce themselves, and make their case as to why they are the right choice for 2018.

**Colorado Governor Republican Primary Candidate Image Ratings**

For this survey, we tested the image rating of four candidates. Not surprisingly, Walker Stapleton and Cynthia Coffman, both being statewide elected officials, were the most well-known of the four, with 77% of voters having an opinion or having heard of those two candidates. Between the two candidates Walker Stapleton currently has a stronger image rating than Cynthia Coffman, with 33% of respondents having a favorable opinion of him and 13% having an unfavorable opinion of him. Among all respondents, 20% have a favorable opinion of Cynthia Coffman and 21% have an unfavorable opinion.

One interesting observation is Victor Mitchell’s name recognition. Among all respondents, 48% have never heard of him. Considering his campaign has spent more than \$800,000 through January 15<sup>th</sup>, one would expect better name recognition.

**Donald Trump Job Approval**

President Trump’s job approval numbers among Colorado Republican primary voters has remained above 80% since we began tracking it in March of 2017. Currently 82% of Republican primary voters approve of the job the President is doing and 13% disapprove. The bottom line is the President is a rock star among the Republican base. For the Colorado Republican candidates for Governor, there arguably should be some upside for those that can demonstrate loyalty and support for the President and his agenda.

**Congressional Republican Job Approval**

With the Republican Party in full control of Congress, we prefer to ask voters if they approve or disapprove of “the job the Republicans in Congress are doing”, rather than the traditional “the job Congress is doing”. Among likely Colorado Republican primary voters, only 35% approve of the job the Republicans in Congress are doing and just under half, 49%, disapprove of the job they are doing. In October of 2017, before the tax reform was passed, only 14% of Republican primary voters approved of the job the Republicans in Congress were doing and 78% disapproved.

**Conclusion**

The fact is it’s still early in the Colorado Republican primary election for Governor. At this time, Walker Stapleton is the clear frontrunner with a 13-point lead over Cynthia Coffman. However, with 39% of likely voters yet to choose a candidate the outcome is far from certain. We look forward to tracking Republican primary voter opinion right up to June 26<sup>th</sup> Republican Primary.

The interviews were conducted February 26<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.85% at the 95 percent confidence interval. This survey was weighted based upon past Republican primary election voting demographics.

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**Survey Methodology**

This survey was conducted using automated telephone touchtone technology. The sample used for this survey was randomly drawn from a state of Colorado voter file. The survey response data was weighted based upon past Republican primary election voting demographics. The interviews were conducted on February 26<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Three attempts were made to interview each household in the sample. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.85% at the 95 percent confidence interval.
