RE: COLORADO 5th CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT PRIMARY SURVEY SUMMARY

This memorandum is a summary of an automated voice recorded survey of 519 likely Republican primary voters in the 5th Congressional District of Colorado. The interviews were conducted on May 20th and 21st, 2018. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.30% at the 95 percent confidence interval. The results were weighted to reflect the voter turnout demographics of past Republican primary elections in the 5th Congressional District of Colorado.

Survey Findings

With two weeks before primary ballots are mailed to Republican primary voters, our survey in the 5th Congressional District of Colorado finds six-term incumbent Congressman Doug Lamborn currently leading El Paso County Commissioner Darryl Glenn by 10 points, 37% to 27% respectively. State Senator Owen Hill is in third place with 10% support. Former Green Mountain Falls Mayor Tyler Stevens has 3% support and former Texas judge Bill Rhea has 2% support. Twenty-one percent of respondents are undecided.

We view these results as an old movie that most Colorado veteran political observers have seen before. Since Doug Lamborn first was first elected in 2006, he has successfully defeated well-funded primary challengers in both 2008 and 2012. Will the 2018 primary

produce a different outcome? While a Doug Lamborn loss is entirely possible based on the results of this survey, the challenge is much more difficult when voters have more than one non-Lamborn candidate to choose from. This observation becomes very clear when you combine Darryl Glenn’s 27% support with Owen Hill’s 10% support, matching the 37% support for Doug Lamborn.

Despite this observation, Doug Lamborn’s support levels among key Republican primary voter subgroups is impressive. Fifty-one percent of respondents approve of the job he is doing, and only 33% disapprove. He currently has a 24-point lead over Darryl Glenn among seniors aged 65 and older, which historically contribute 44% to the total primary vote. He holds an 8-point lead over Darryl Glenn among self-identified Trump Republicans, a 20-point lead among self-identified Traditional Republicans, and a 13-point lead among Evangelical, Christian Republicans. Doug Lamborn’s cross-over appeal among these relevant Republican primary voter subgroups is why he is so hard to defeat.

The bottom line is the Republican primary for the 5th Congressional District is far from over with 21% of voters being undecided. The candidates will continue to spend the bulk of their financial resources over the next several weeks making their best case to voters. A 5-point increase in support for Darryl Glenn combined with a 5-point decrease in support for Doug Lamborn will produce a very tight race. We shall see what happens.

Colorado 5th Congressional District Republican Primary Candidate Image Ratings

Currently Doug Lamborn and Darryl Glenn have similar image ratings, with just over 50% of respondents having a favorable opinion of both candidates. However, the percentage of voters that have an unfavorable opinion of Doug Lamborn, 31%, is slightly higher than the 20% of voters that have an unfavorable opinion of Darryl Glenn.

Owen Hill’s image rating is clearly worse than Doug Lamborn or Darryl Glenn’s. Fifty-five percent of voters either have no opinion or have never heard of him. Among the 45% of voters that have an opinion of him, 24% have a favorable opinion and 21% have an unfavorable opinion of him. If Owen Hill is going to be competitive in this election these numbers need to improve significantly and quickly, with ballots being returned in just over two weeks there is very little time to make that happen.

Colorado Governor Republican Primary Ballot Test

With El Paso County historically contributing close to 20% of all Republican primary ballots cast in the state, we asked a Republican Primary Governor ballot test question. Among all respondents, 32% currently support Walker Stapleton, 18% support Victor Mitchell, 8% support Doug Robinson, 8% support Greg Lopez and 34% are undecided. This was the first time we have looked at this race since the field of candidates was finalized.

In our view, the emergence of Victor Mitchell as the primary challenger to Walker Stapleton is obviously the biggest finding. While this sample, and the ballot test results could be representative of statewide Republican primary voter opinion, we want to be clear that it is not. We stress to everyone reading this survey summary to keep that in mind.

Conclusion

At this time the Republican primary election for the 5th Congressional District is a two-horse race with incumbent Congressman Doug Lamborn currently having the inside track. He currently leads El Paso County Commissioner Darryl Glenn by 10-points, 37% to 27% respectively and a significant 21% of voters being undecided. Both candidates show strong image rating numbers and Doug Lamborn also shows a solid job approval rating. The bottom line is the race could become very close, very quickly with a 5-point move in support for each candidate. We look forward to observing this Republican primary battle to its conclusion.

Survey Methodology

This survey was conducted using automated telephone touchtone technology. The sample used for this survey was randomly drawn from a state of Colorado voter file. The survey response data was weighted based upon past Republican primary election voting demographics. The interviews were conducted on May 20th – 21st, 2018. Three attempts were made to interview each household in the sample. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.3% at the 95 percent confidence interval.
