RE: COLORADO 2018 GOVERNOR REPUBLICAN PRIMARY SURVEY SUMMARY

This memorandum is a summary of an automated voice recorded and cell phone survey of 593 likely Republican primary voters in Colorado. The interviews were conducted on June 6th and 7th, 2018. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.02% at the 95 percent confidence interval. The results were weighted to reflect the voter turnout demographics of past Republican primary elections in Colorado.

Survey Findings

Treasurer Walker Stapleton currently leads the Republican primary field for Governor with a 13-point lead and 36% support. His closest challenger is businessman Victor Mitchell with 23% support. Former Parker Mayor Greg Lopez has 10% support, Doug Robinson has 4% and 27% of likely Republican primary voters are undecided. Among male voters, Walker Stapleton holds a commanding 23-point lead over Victor Mitchell. Among female voters the election is much tighter and within the survey margin of error. Among seniors aged 65 and older, the most dominant and important Republican primary voter sub-group, Walker Stapleton leads Victor Mitchell by 24 points, 47% to 23% respectively.

This contest is far from over, with Victor Mitchell finally being able to build some momentum after spending more than a million dollars introducing himself to voters. A major factor that will decide this race is if Victor Mitchell’s attack ads are effective moving voters away from Walker Stapleton. The truth is, nobody really knows the answer

to that question just yet. For Victor Mitchell to be in a position to win, his negative ads have to work with only two weeks to Election Day. We are somewhat surprised the timing of Victor Mitchell’s attack ads coming so late in the election. Past ballot return data show Colorado Republican primary voters return their ballots early. This is thought to be because nearly 50% of likely voters are aged 65 and older, retired and have more time on their hands. More than 35% of the total Republican primary vote could be cast by the end of this week.

Colorado Governor Republican Candidate Image Ratings

Walker Stapleton has a very strong image rating with 51% of likely voters having a favorable opinion of him and only 15% having an unfavorable opinion of him. With only two weeks to go before Election Day, the Stapleton Campaign and his campaign independent expenditure group have done a good job introducing and positioning him among likely Republican primary voters. Victor Mitchell’s image rating is respectable with 39% of respondents having a favorable opinion of him and 15% having an unfavorable opinion of him. However, Victor Mitchell’s name recognition could be better, with 26% of likely voters having heard of him but do not have an opinion of him, and 20% of respondents having never heard of him.

In comparing the two candidate image ratings, it is hard not to see the significant challenge the Mitchell Campaign faces in driving voters away from Walker Stapleton. Particularly among seniors aged 65 and older, who are nearly 50% of the total vote. Among those senior voters, nearly 6 in 10 have a favorable opinion of Walker Stapleton. As we pointed out before, the attack ads targeting Walker Stapleton need to be very effective for Victor Mitchell to be in a position to win this election.

Conclusion

With two weeks before Election Day, is the Republican nomination for Governor a done deal? Based on the findings of this survey, absolutely not. However, it is hard to argue that Walker Stapleton does not have the inside track and that Victor Mitchell has a more difficult path to victory. One final observation of the dynamics of this race is that Walker Stapleton's Campaign and his campaign independent expenditure group are likely to begin attacking Victor Mitchell. They also have the resources to do it and it would make the most sense. We shall see.

Survey Methodology

This survey was conducted by live dialing cell phones and using automated telephone touchtone technology. The sample used for this survey was randomly drawn from a state of Colorado voter file. The survey response data was weighted based upon past Republican primary election voting demographics. The interviews were conducted on June 6th - 7th, 2018. Three attempts were made to interview each household in the sample. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.02% at the 95 percent confidence interval.
