## Colorado February Issue Voter Opinion Survey Topline Results, Release 2 of 2

Magellan Strategies are pleased to present the topline results of an online survey of 769 Colorado registered voters. The interviews were conducted from February 9<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.53% at the 95 percent confidence interval. The survey data was weighted to be representative of the demographics of the registered voter population in Colorado.
