## Colorado Coronavirus Survey

### Topline Results

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Magellan Strategies are pleased to present the topline results of an online survey of 545 adult Colorado residents. The interviews were conducted from June 3<sup>rd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.2% at the 95 percent confidence interval. The survey data was weighted to be representative of the registered voter population demographics in Colorado.
